U.S. Arms Company welcomes you into our family of customers. We truly appreciate your business. You accept these Terms and Conditions when you place an order with U.S. Arms Company (USAC). Please read carefully.

Legal

It is the customer's responsibility to follow all Federal, State, and Local Laws. It is your (customer) responsibility to know if you meet the legal requirements for ordering any product, whether the restriction is for age, area in which you live, or other reason. Items include but are not limited to firearms, ammunition, or magazines.

Certain items governed by the ATF cannot be shipped to the customer and must be shipped to an FFL. U.S. Arms Company, LLC takes no responsibility for any items refused by your FFL. Prior to placing your order, you must make arrangements with an FFL of your choice to ensure they will transfer the product(s) you intend to order.

When purchasing firearms, you acknowledge, understand, and agree:

- You must be 21 years old to purchase a receiver, or hand guns
- You must be 18 years old to purchase long guns
- You possess valid U.S. identification
- You are the actual transferee/buyer/purchaser of the firearms on this order
- Firearms and receivers are sent to licensed FFL dealers only
- USAC must have the dealer's FFL on file before USAC will ship
- You, the customer, must have the dealer's permission for USAC to ship to them for transfer prior to placing your order with USAC
 - Expect the following from the dealer before they can transfer the firearm or receiver to you:
 - A Federal background check will be conducted on you
 - Your age will be verified
 - You will be responsible for paying a transfer fee and/or a background check fee
 - Check with the dealer in advance to learn the fee amount prior to placing your order with USAC
 - After the transfer, the sale is considered final and is not eligible for return
- You understand that firearms are inherently dangerous and you accept full liability for product failure or misuse. You also accept full responsibility and

liability for the proper use and storage of any firearms you buy or have in your possession.

- Review of Customer Responsibilities related to FFL
 - Contact your FFL of choice prior to placing your order. Verify the following:
 - They will accept the transfer for all of the items on your order
 - They are currently in business
 - Their current address matches what is listed on the USAC site for your order
 - Fees they will charge you for the transfer
 - U.S. Arms Company is not responsible for any issues that result from your failure to follow these steps
 - FFLs listed on the USAC site are completely independent - the list is provided for your convenience
